ANNOUNCEMENT

ISSUANCE OF ¥6,300,000,000 IN AGGREGATE PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF FLOATING RATE NOTES PURSUANT TO THE S\$2,000,000,000 MULTICURRENCY MEDIUM TERM NOTE PROGRAMME

CapitaCommercial Trust Management Limited (the “**Manager**”), as manager of CapitaCommercial Trust (CCT), wishes to announce that CCT MTN Pte. Ltd. (the “**Issuer**”), a wholly owned subsidiary of CCT, has issued ¥6,300,000,000 floating rate notes due 31 October 2021 (the “**Notes**”). The Notes are issued under the S\$2,000,000,000 Multicurrency Medium Term Note Programme (the “**MTN Programme**”) established by the Issuer on 20 November 2007. Currently the aggregate outstanding principal amount of notes issued pursuant to the MTN Programme is S\$ 543,300,000. The obligations of the Issuer under the Notes are unconditionally and irrevocably guaranteed by the HSBC Institutional Trust Services (Singapore) Limited, in its capacity as trustee of CCT (the “**CCT Trustee**”).

The Notes will mature on 31 October 2021, with interest payable on a floating rate basis quarterly in arrear.

The Issuer has entered into swap transactions to swap the Yen proceeds amounting to ¥ 6,300,000,000 into Singapore dollars amounting to S\$75,000,000 at a Singapore dollar fixed interest rate of 2.95 per cent. per annum.

The Issuer will lend the proceeds from the issuance of the Notes to the CCT Trustee, who will in turn use such proceeds to refinance existing borrowings of CCT and the subsidiaries, to on-lend to any entity in which CCT has an interest, to finance any capital expenditure and asset enhancement works initiated by CCT and for the general working capital of CCT.

Pursuant to Rule 704(31) of the Listing Manual of the Singapore Exchange Securities Trading Limited (the “**SGX-ST**”), it is an event of default under the Notes if the Manager is removed as manager of CCT and the replacement or substitute manager is not appointed in accordance with the terms of the trust deed constituting CCT. If the condition is breached, it may trigger cross defaults in the other facilities, debt issues and borrowings of CCT and/or its subsidiaries. In such an event, the aggregate level of facilities, debt issues and borrowings that may be affected is approximately S\$1,448.6 million (including the Notes but excluding interest) as at the present date. As at the date of this announcement, there has not been a breach of the condition described above.
